- Living Shores is hiring across all positions both within the aquarium and at The Bistro. Full time and part time positions are available, including full-time animal care positions where team members will be working with the aquarium’s otters and lorikeets. Living Shores is now offering up to \$17 per hour for select positions.
- Water Country is currently hiring more than 250 employees across all departments including lifeguards, retail, security and more. The park is offering up to \$20 per hour, depending on position and will cover the cost of lifeguard certifications for those interested in the unique role. All roles offer opportunities for growth and bonuses throughout the summer.

“We plan to return to daily operations this summer, so we’re all hands on deck to build a great team,” said Water Country General Manager Matt Hehl. “Dedicated team members that join the Water Country Water Park team this summer will have the opportunity to participate in team-wide events and activities throughout the entire season. All of our positions also offer opportunity for growth and advancement within the park.”

Water Country, Story Land and Living Shores will host in-person job fairs this spring, though intrigued individuals can dive in today by applying online. Seasonal jobs are available for teens as young as 14 years old, and also offer great opportunities for professionals and retirees looking for a flexible part-time job. Seasonal workers receive free admission to visit not just these three locations all summer long, but also sister parks elsewhere in New England, including Lake Compounce and Splish Splash.
