- ☞ Dress appropriately. Personal grooming & cleanliness are a must working at Story Land.
- ☞ Avoid gum chewing, excessive jewelry, & makeup.
- ☞ Body Language: Sit up straight & maintain eye contact.
- ☞ Ask questions, show enthusiasm & interest, and avoid one-word responses to questions.
- ☞ Thank the interviewer for their time & shake their hand on the way out.
